

Würdigungspreis für Dr. Milja Radovic, MA PhD

On 10. November Milja Radovic received the prestigious honorary prize of the Quo Vadis International Film Festival 2024. The Plaque – Sign of Gratitude was bestowed on Dr. Radovic for “the Christian witness she gives in her research and for the friendship shown to the Quo Vadis International Film Festival.” The ceremony took place in the Aula Magna Carmen Sylva of the University of Iași in Iași, Romania, the oldest university in the country, and the award was bestowed on Dr. Radovic by His Grace Teofan, Archbishop of Iași and Metropolitan of Moldova and Bukovina. The title *Quo Vadis?* is inspired by the historical novel by Henryk Sienkiewicz and the aim of the Festival is to cultivate the spiritual and cultural heritage of Christianity through film and encourage dialogue and communion within and beyond the community. Among those who received special recognition included Georgian artist and photographer Yuri Mechitov (for artistic freedom), Gulbara Tolomushova (for the testimony of identity values of Kyrgyz cinema) and Chris Vlahonasios (for the fulfillment of the fruitful mission through culture). Further distinguished recipients of the Festival included Archimandrite Ephraim of Vatopedi Monastery, artistic director Elena Dulgheru and Emmy award-winning actor Jonathan Jackson.
